

Quick Checklist: How to Add Google Tag Manager to Your Website

1. Create a GTM Account and Container

- ☐ Go to tagmanager.google.com and sign in with your Google account
 - ☐ Click "**Create Account**", enter your account and website name
 - ☐ Choose **Web** as the platform and accept the terms
 - ☐ Click **Create** and accept the terms of service
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2. Get Your GTM Code Snippets

- ☐ After creating the container, copy the two GTM code snippets:
 - one for the <head> section
 - one for the <body> section
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3. Add the GTM Code to Your Website

a) On a standard HTML site or via a developer

- ☐ Paste the first (script) snippet right after the opening <head> tag
- ☐ Paste the second (noscript) snippet right after the opening <body> tag

b) On WordPress

- ☐ Install a plugin like **Insert Headers and Footers** or **GTM4WP**
- ☐ Paste the first code into the HEAD section
- ☐ Paste the second code into the BODY or Footer section

c) On other platforms (Shopify, Shoptet, Wix...)

- ☐ Use a specific plugin or GTM section in your platform's admin area
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4. Verify GTM Installation

- ☐ Go back to GTM and click on "**Preview**"
 - ☐ Enter your website URL and check if GTM is loading correctly (via debug mode)
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5. Publish the GTM Container

- ☐ If everything works, click **Submit → Publish** in GTM
- ☐ Add a version name (e.g. "Initial GTM install")
