## **Quick Checklist: How to Add Google Tag Manager to Your Website**

1. Create a GTWI Account and Container
☐ Go to <u>tagmanager.google.com</u> and sign in with your Google account
☐ Click "Create Account", enter your account and website name
☐ Choose <b>Web</b> as the platform and accept the terms
☐ Click <b>Create</b> and accept the terms of service
2. Get Your GTM Code Snippets
☐ After creating the container, copy the two GTM code snippets:
• one for the <head> section</head>
one for the <body> section</body>
3. Add the GTM Code to Your Website
a) On a standard HTML site or via a developer
$\square$ Paste the first (script) snippet right after the opening <head> tag</head>
$\square$ Paste the second (noscript) snippet right after the opening sody> tag
b) On WordPress
☐ Install a plugin like <b>Insert Headers and Footers</b> or <b>GTM4WP</b>
☐ Paste the first code into the HEAD section
☐ Paste the second code into the BODY or Footer section
c) On other platforms (Shopify, Shoptet, Wix)
$\square$ Use a specific plugin or GTM section in your platform's admin area
4. Verify GTM Installation
☐ Go back to GTM and click on "Preview"
☐ Enter your website URL and check if GTM is loading correctly (via debug mode)
5. Publish the GTM Container
☐ If everything works, click <b>Submit</b> → <b>Publish</b> in GTM
☐ Add a version name (e.g. "Initial GTM install")
